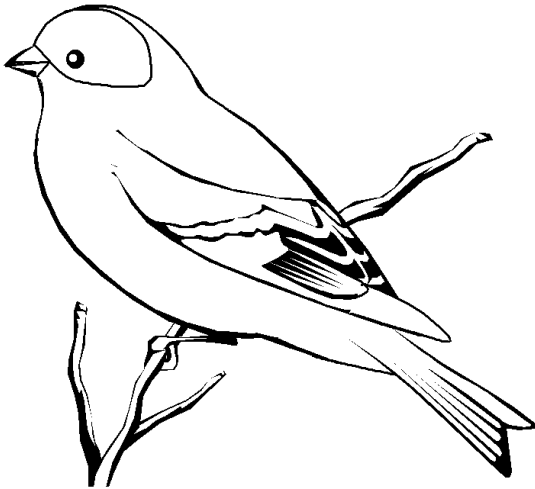

# Eastern Goldfinch

- The main foods of the Eastern Goldfinch are the seeds of dandelions, sunflowers, ragweed and evening primrose.
- Each year, the female lays 4 to 6 whitish-blue eggs marked at the larger end with reddish-brown spots.
- The Eastern Goldfinch was adopted as New Jersey's state bird in on January 29, 1935.
